Career Overview:

A medical scribe is a person who specializes in charting physician-patient encounters in real time during medical examinations. They follow the physician through his/her work day and chart patient encounters in real-time using a EMR. This allows the physician to increase patient contact time, give more time where needed and better manage patient flow through the department.

Job Duties May Include:

- Accompany the physician into the exam room
- Document the history of the patient's present illness
- Document the Review-of-Systems (ROS) and physical examination
- Look up pertinent past medical records
- Prioritize the physician's time by bringing critical lab results to his/her attention
- Type progress notes
- Enter the patient's discharge plan and any prescriptions
- Document patient encounters
