Virginia Ready enables Virginians to acquire the skills and resources they need to succeed in a competitive job market, while uplifting the value of credential based scholars. Virginia Ready scholars are Virginians who seize the moment and commit themselves to training for in-demand jobs.

Applicants must be enrolled in an approved course through our educational partners, complete career readiness training, and upon earning their credential, they will receive a \$1,000 Credential Achievement Award.

During the Scholar Journey, they receive resume support, career coaching, and have access to our Employer Network: leading companies in Virginia that are hiring in healthcare, business/IT, and skilled trades industries.

#### THE SCHOLAR JOURNEY

#### 1. ESTABLISH YOUR CAREER PATH

Enroll in a Supported Course with one of our Education Partners.

#### 2. APPLY TO BE A SCHOLAR

You must submit your application prior to or within 5 calendar days of your class starting.

#### 3. MAINTAIN YOUR SCHOLAR STATUS

After your application has been accepted, you must complete your career plan within 30 calendar days.

#### 4. COMPLETE CAREER READINESS TRAINING

Scholars are expected to complete the Career Readiness Training offered by the Virginia Talent Opportunity Partnership by the time you finish your credential and are encouraged to attend workshops led by our partners.

#### 5. ACCESS EMPLOYER NETWORK

Begin your career search journey and connect with Virginia Ready hiring partners!

#### 6. EARN & SUBMIT YOUR CREDENTIAL

To complete your Scholar Journey and receive the \$1,000 Credential Achievement Award, you must submit your credential within 150 calendar days of completing your course, along with completing the Career Readiness training requirements.

Virginia Ready Scholar Eligibility Requirements: to be eligible for our program, applicants must be in a supported course, adhere to the 5 day calendar day application deadline, and provide proof of residency within the State of Virginia for at least one year (domicile).

\*If you are enrolled with a community college, they must prove domicile at the time of course enrollment.
