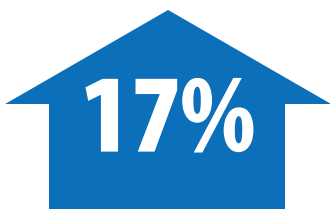
The results are in! Over 30 frontline leaders completed 40 hours of training with LEADERSHIP BASECAMP and we measured the impact.



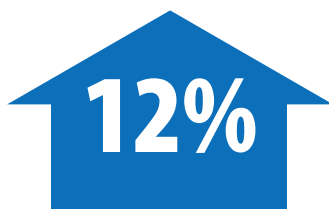

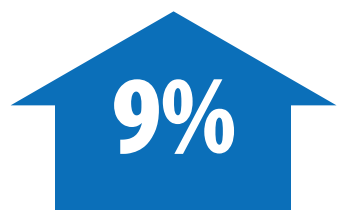

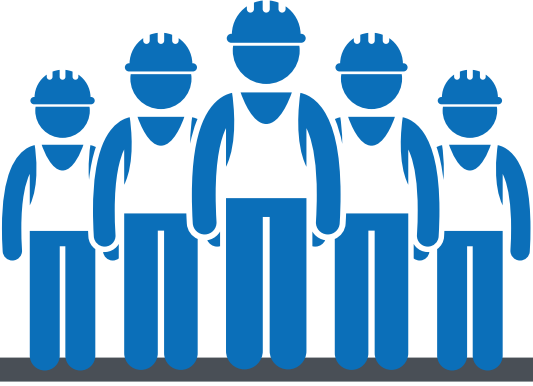
